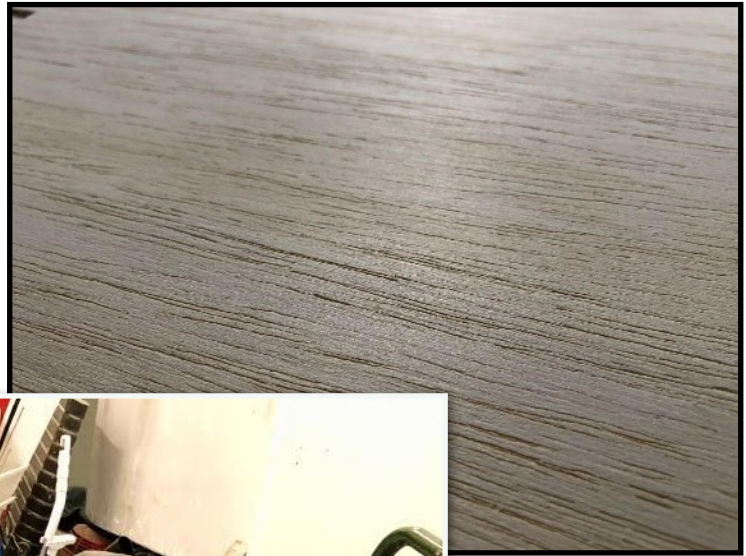


Ron Gray, Xtra Wot build, 6

Having worked on 2 models recently with foam veneered wings I've got to say that the Warbird Replicas' ones are superior to the Chris Foss ones, the grain on the Xtra Wot is really coarse and quite prominent.



Notwithstanding this I started the covering with the underside of the wings, well actually I decided to do all of the black bits first, leaving the control surfaces until later as they will need the control horn hard points fitting first.

My normal practice is to cover wings in pieces to make it easier to handle but this time I decided to do it in one.

Underside of the tailplane.



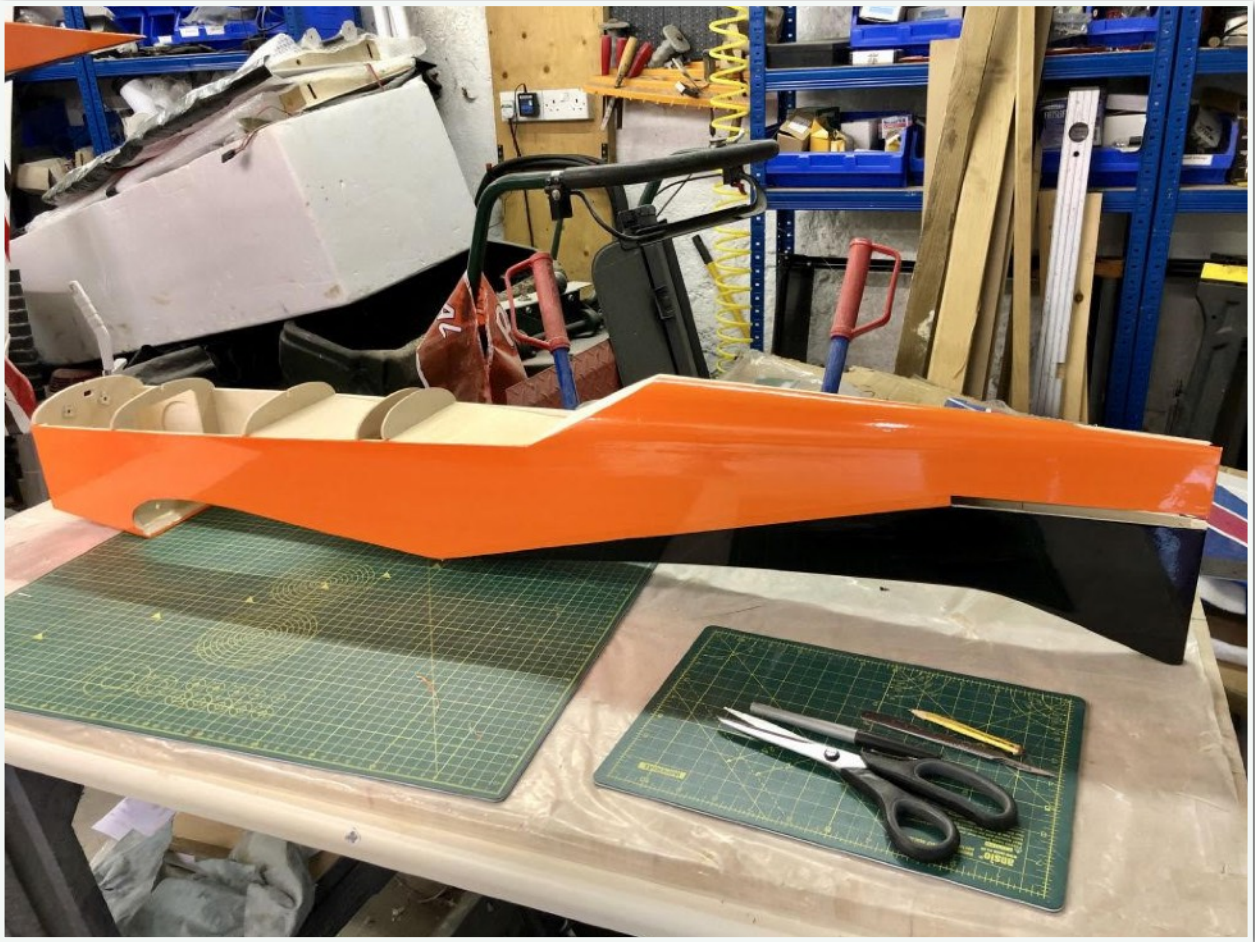
And some bits on the sides of the fuse.
